Children 12-18 months

We are excited to introduce arts and activities to children 12-18 months old. Studies have shown that introducing art to children at a young age can build fine motor skills, promote creativity, introduce them to writing, and so much more. Through themed workshops, little artists will be introduced to many art mediums, including paint and chalk. We ask that parents stay with their children and help them along as they create and explore. Workshops are 90 minutes each for two days. Camp fee is \$20 members / \$25 non-members of Laurel Arts.

ARTventurers

Children 18-36 months

This series is designed for toddlers, ages 18-36 months. Each session lasts 2 hours and is filled with art projects designed for small artists. Participants will have a chance to experiment with creativity while enhancing fine motor skills. In the Artventurers series, toddlers will be introduced to a structured class while participating in fun art projects that will take them to adventurous places such as the Best of Disney, through some of their favorite storybooks, and back in time. Our sessions are not just limited to art but also include games, stories, and cooking/baking. Choose either a three-day morning session or a five-day afternoon session. Dress to get messy! Camp fee for the 3-Day Session is \$32 members / \$40 non-Members; 5-Day Session is \$40 members / \$50 non-members.

Children Pre-K through 3rd grade

These workshops are designed for children going into Pre-k through 3rd grade. Students will use a variety of art mediums to create projects and will also create delicious snacks, and participate in fun games.

June 21-25 Camp Crayon Melted crayon creations, water scenes of Monet, painting with items from around the house ... Join us for a week of all things art! Students will create works of art with crayons, paints, clay and more. This workshop will give young artists a look at different types of art and lots of ways to get creative.

July 5-9 Art Safari Explore the wild kingdom through art! Lions, tigers, and bears ... oh my! We will learn about many kinds of animals this week. And, we will take what we learn a step further by creating animal inspired art.

July 19-23 Story Inspired Cooking Camp A monkey bread for *Curious George*, pancakes from scratch for *If You Give a Pig a Pancake*, and a delicious blueberry dessert for *Blueberries for Sal* are just a few of the amazing story inspired recipes we'll be creating this week. We will be reading lots of our favorite books and then preparing recipes to go along with them. Cooking camps are always a favorite at Laurel Arts. Come hungry!

August 9-13 Croods Camp This week we will travel back to the Croodaceous Period. We will learn about dinosaurs and recreate them as art, create cave drawings of long ago, and mix up a recipe to craft a bone necklace.

Children 4th through 7th grade

ARTolescents is designed for children entering grades 4 through 7. This age group will experience more advanced art lessons. Students will not only use their creativity to complete art projects but will also learn about famous artists and a variety of art mediums.

June 14-18 Arts Galore During our first ARTolescent camp of the summer, we will explore various types of art. We will use a variety of mediums, from clay to wire to paints. We will introduce you to so many ways to be creative and help you discover your favorite types of art and possibly even a new hobby!

July 12-16 Getting to Know Our Community This week we will learn about some of the history of Somerset and surrounding areas. We'll learn about famous architect Frank Lloyd Wright, make some delicious maple syrup recipes, and learn about famous people such as Mr. Rogers. For more learning fun, one day of camp will be spent touring local businesses!

July 26-30 Time Travelers Camp Throughout this week-long camp, we will travel through many time periods. We'll start in the age of dinosaurs and create some look-alike amber fossils from resin. We'll learn about famous artists and musicians of the Renaissance period and recreate some of their famous works. We'll travel to the 60s and create some tie dye, learn the science behind lava lamps, and much more!

August 2-6 Special Events Cooking Camp Join us for a busy week of cooking and taste testing.
