WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER?

ALL MEMBERS OF THE SCAA ARE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. This is a non-juried show. All work submitted must be original art. Artist must offer at least one piece of work for sale.



WHAT ARE THE ENTRY FEES?

1 piece	\$6 Total
2 pieces	\$7 Total
3-5 pieces	\$8 Total



WHAT SHOULD ACCOMPANY ENTRIES?

Two 3" x 5" cards must accompany EACH entry listing the following information. (Please print or type info) artist's name, address, telephone number, title of work, medium, size, price (if for sale) or NFS (if not for sale). One 3x5 card gets attached to the artwork and the other gets turned in to the office staff upon drop off. *Unless otherwise noted* on the drop-off card submitted to staff, by entering artwork in this exhibit, the artist understands and agrees that Laurel Arts will display the exhibit virtually on their website and social media. That Laurel Arts reserves the right to reproduce and distribute the images through print and/or electronic media for promotion of the exhibition. That the artist grants Laurel Arts the right to allow authorized agents to photograph and/or videotape the artwork and to use or reproduce the artwork for publicity and educational purposes. The artist confirms there are no existing copyrights on the submitted piece(s) that interfere with these conditions and that the artist will retain all copyrights.



IN WHAT FORM SHOULD PIECES BE ENTERED?

Each entry (except sculpture) must be framed, wired, sturdy, and ready to hang (no sawtooth hangers). All work not properly readied for hanging may be disqualified. Size of painting not to exceed forty-eight (48) inches (including frame) in any direction.



WHEN SHOULD THE ART BE DROPPED OFF?

Entries should be delivered August 17th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., 19 and 20, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. to the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts, 214 Harrison Ave., Somerset, PA 15501. All works will remain on center premises through September 26. Work should be picked up Saturday, September 28th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. All artwork not picked up within thirty (30) days from the close of the exhibit becomes the property of Laurel Arts.

Entries will be handled with all possible care, however S.C.A.A. nor the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts will be held responsible for any loss or damage. Sales and sales tax will be handled by the Dressler Center. Laurel Arts receives 30% commission.
