#### ENTRY PROCEDURES

Multi-media, open to all artists, 18 years and older. Entries must be original art work executed in the last two years and must not have been exhibited in any previous SCAA or Laurel Arts shows. Each artist may submit up to three entries for a non-refundable entry fee of \$20 made payable to SCAA. (Categories may be mixed.) Artist must offer at least one piece of work for sale.

Entries may be dropped off at the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts, 214 Harrison Ave., Somerset, PA **June 14, from 10 am to 2 pm; June 16 and 17 from 11 am to 6 pm.** Work not accepted must be picked up no later than June 21. You will be notified by phone if your work **is not** accepted.

Two cards must accompany each entry listing the artist's name, address, phone number, title of work, size, medium and the price (if for sale) and NFS if not for sale. Attach one of the cards to the back of your entry. *Unless otherwise noted* on the drop-off card submitted to staff, by entering artwork in this exhibit, the artist understands and agrees that Laurel Arts will display the exhibit virtually on their website and social media. That Laurel Arts reserves the right to reproduce and distribute the images through print and/or electronic media for promotion of the exhibition. That the artist grants Laurel Arts the right to allow authorized agents to photograph and/or videotape the artwork and to use or reproduce the artwork for publicity and educational purposes. The artist confirms there are no existing copyrights on the submitted piece(s) that interfere with these conditions and that the artist will retain all copyrights.
