Parade Rules and Regulations

General Information for Participants

Line-up will begin at 5:00 pm on South Center Avenue and Church Street. Your position in line will be assigned the week of the parade. E-mails will be sent out. Please make sure that you provided an email on the application for us to contact you.

The parade route line-up begins at South Center Avenue and Church Street. Parade route follows Main Street to Franklin Avenue and disbands at Franklin Avenue and Patriot Street. Note: Units other than Fire Equipment must approach line-up from the South Side (come up from Cannel Drive by the Morocco Building).

Applications must be received by July 18, 2025, in order to receive a parade position assignment. Late applicants will be assigned to the end of the parade. No exceptions. Parade participants must check in with parade officials on S Center in front of Wheeler Medical Center during line up for their parade position.

Groups may perform as long as the performance is done en route in order to keep the parade moving in an orderly fashion; thus, parade participants will not be allowed to stop in the parade route to perform.

Parade participants are not allowed to throw candy from floats or vehicles. We encourage you to have walkers accompany you along the parade route to pass out candy and/or other materials to bystanders.

If children are walking, they must be accompanied by adults!

Commercial Businesses

Commercial businesses may enter up to 4 units.

Please note that there will be no judging this year.
