WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER?

ALL CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE SCAA ARE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. This is a non-juried show. All work submitted must be original art. Artist must offer at least one piece of work for sale.



WHAT ARE THE ENTRY FEE?

1 or 2 pieces \$15 Total

SCAA can only accept cash or checks for the exhibit entry fee. They cannot accept credit or debit cards.



WHAT SHOULD ACCOMPANY ENTRIES?

Two 3" x 5" cards accompany each entry listing: artist's name, address, phone number, work title, medium, size, and price (if for sale) or NFS (if not). One card attaches to the artwork, the other to the SCAA volunteer upon drop-off. By entering artwork, the artist agrees Laurel Arts will display it virtually on their website and social media. Laurel Arts reserves the right to reproduce images for exhibition promotion. The artist grants Laurel Arts the right to photograph, videotape, and use the artwork for publicity and education. The artist confirms no existing copyrights interfere with these conditions and retains all copyrights. Please include a short narrative what Laurel Arts has meant to you. See additional sheet.



IN WHAT FORM SHOULD PIECES BE ENTERED?

Each entry (except sculpture) must be framed, wired, sturdy, and ready to hang (no sawtooth hangers). All work not properly readied for hanging may be disqualified. Size of painting not to exceed forty-eight (48) inches (including frame) in any direction.



WHEN SHOULD THE ART BE DROPPED OFF?

Entries should be delivered Saturday, June 13th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday June 15th from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. to the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts, 214 Harrison Ave., Somerset, PA 15501. All works will remain on center premises through July 16. Work should be picked up Saturday, July 18th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. All artwork not picked up within thirty (30) days from the close of the exhibit becomes the property of Laurel Arts.

Entries will be handled with all possible care, however S.C.A.A. nor the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts will be held responsible for any loss or damage. Sales and sales tax will be handled by the Dressler Center. A total commission of 50% is distributed, with 30% allocated to Laurel Arts and the S.C.A.A., resulting in a 20% commission.





LAUREL ARTS WAS INCORPORATED IN 1975, however we did not own this beautiful home until 7/7/1976. The Somerset County Artists Association pre-dates Laurel Arts' existence by about 25 years and those early SCAA members were very instrumental in the formation of Laurel Arts.

This year we will be hosting an exhibit (50 Years @ Dressler) to coincide with the SCAA Member Show that incorporates history items about the building and the land with some interesting facts and photographs.

FOR THIS EXHIBIT, please include a short narrative about what Laurel Arts has meant to you. This can include things such as:

- How has Laurel Arts impacted your life or artistic journey in a positive way?
- Do you remember the first time you exhibited here?
- What are your earliest memories of being involved with Laurel Arts?

The piece(s) you choose to exhibit does not have to be new work. It can be old work and new work together to show your growth or how you have changed as an artist. It can be your first piece you worked on or showed at Laurel Arts.
