without the help of our volunteers, staff, and amazing dance families. Thank you to everyone who helped make the recital a success!



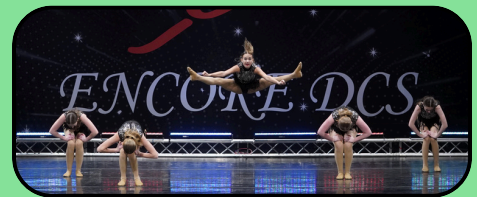
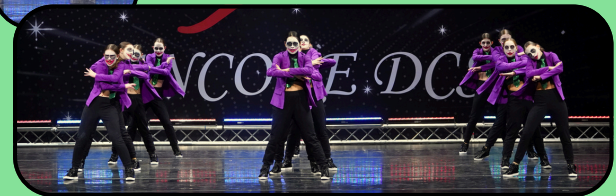
